Messrs. W. and L. E. Hurst, who were in the woolen business, entered into contract with Messrs. John and Charles Leneghen to quarry, cut and lay the complete stone work for the total prices as follows:

\$110.00 in cash
150.00 in live stock
50.00 in boots and shoes
340.00 in full cloth @ 1.00 per yd.

Mrs. Lou H. Lamb, granddaughter of Mr. W. Hurst, is now the present owner.
