Carnegie Mellon University Campus. Brick and terra cotta, cylindrical, 63' high. Notable features are the terra cotta ornamental work, cantilevered stairs and brick arches. Built 1914, Henry Hornbostel, Architect. The tower is an excellent example of the eclectic Beaux Arts style of the early 20th C. It was Hornbostel's final solution to the problem of creating a focal point to end the axis of his competition-winning scheme for the campus
