1-1/2 mi. NNE. of Limekiln (Oley Line). Typical, log cabin of the earliest Pennsylvania-German, 20' x 30'; one-and-a-half stories, gable roof flared at the eaves, interior divided by large, stone, kitchen fireplace placed slightly off-center, corner stairs.
