330 Arch St. Brick, approx. 180' (thirteen-bay front) x 85', two stories, hipped roof with cross gable, projecting central pavilion, three porches with Tuscan columns across north side and two each on east and west sides, 1804 date stone in gable end; Quaker plain style. East wing and center building built 1803-05, Owen Biddle,

architect; west wing built 1810-11; one story addition behind west wing built 1896, demolished 1968; two story addition behind center building built 1902, 1906, demolished 1968; interior east wing renovated and two-story addition behind center building built 1968-69, Cope and Lippincott, architects. Oldest Friends Meeting House in Philadelphia and headquarters of Philadelphia Yearly Meeting of the Society of Friends. Property owned by Friends since city's beginning. 4 ext. photos (1958, 1974).
