Spanning Monongahela River, W. Carson St. to Point of Pittsburgh. Coursed ashlar abutments and two river piers supporting steel arched cantilevered trusses with cantilevered side spans, central deck suspended from arched trusses, 1200' over-all length, 430' span for river traffic, 30' roadway, unadorned steel-plate portals.
