- Location: 514 West Main Street Rear, Lock Haven, Clinton County, Pennsylvania
USGS Lock Haven, Universal Transverse Mercator
Coordinates 17.4557100.293800
- Significance: Located on the same parcel as a contributing structure to the Water Street Historic District.
- Description: A two story structure located at the rear of the property along Willard's Alley. The structure is of wood frame construction and two stories in height.

The structure is rectangular in shape with gable roof design. This is an example of vernacular Early American Revival that was built as a tenant residence. The exterior is covered in "insulbrick". The two story front porch was enclosed at a later date. The windows are double hung. There are no distinguished architectural features. The building has been vandalized. It is filled with garbage and debris.
- History: Probably built in the 1920's. The architect and builder are not known. Built as a tenant residence to supplement the income of the owners of main house. It was constructed at the time when the main house was converted into apartments.
