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| PA-6659-18 | South (river) elevation, main building, looking north. |
| PA-6659-19 | View along the south-facing piazza, looking east from the west wing. |
| PA-6659-20 | Door in west wall of the center block, positioned near the detached kitchen/bake house building. |
| PA-6659-21 | First-floor passage, center block, looking north. |
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| PA-6659-23 | Detail, west wall of stair landing between first and second floors, center block. |
| PA-6659-24 | West elevation, southwest first-floor room, main block. This room is believed to be the one referred to as the "Committee Room" in institutional records. |
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- PA-6659-41 Lattice enclosure, cellar passage, main block, looking south. Functioning with vents opened through the masonry in the east and west walls, this partition provided a secure and aerated storage area for foodstuffs used in the nearby kitchen.
- PA-6659-42 General view, northeast cellar room, main block, looking northeast.
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
