Owner: Custodians: Augustine Fathers, San German, P.R.

Date of Erection: First royal grant of 500 ducats made to the Dominican Fathers for the erection of this church, in 1532. Present edifice dates from (circa) 1571.

Architect: Unknown

Buildar: The Dominican Fathers

Present Condition: Badly in need of repairs

Materials of Construction: Rubble-work masonry and damped earth

Other Existing Records: The Historical Archive of Puerto Rico was destroyed by fire in 1926. Documents relating to most of these buildings may be found at Seville, Spain, in the "Archivo de Indias."

Additional Data: Unsuccessful attempts have been made to restore the building by an association named "Comite Pro Restauracion del Convento de Santo Domingo," San German, P. R. Mr. A. Toro Nazario, Secretary.
