The present owner, Miss Abbie P. Gardiner, bought of heirs of Rebecca Hammond, August 25, 1905. (North Kingstown Land Evidence XLIV, 683.)

Rebecca Hammond, wife of George, bought of J. P. C. Shaw and Elizabeth Brenton Shaw, February 6, 1874 (North Kingstown Land Evidence XXXV, 417).

J. P. C. and E. B. Shaw inherited from their mother, Ann Peck Case, who married Dr. William A. Shaw in 1848. (North Kingstown Land Evidence XXXV, 417)

Ann Peck Case inherited from her father, John Peck Case, June 15, 1830. (North Kingstown Probate Records XXXVI, 61).

John Peck Case inherited from his father, Immanuel Case, Ann Maynard (Case) Sands and husband Robert C. quitclaiming. (North Kingstown Probate Records XII, 144 for will, September 24, 1792. North Kingstown land Evidence XV B-50 for deed, August 29, 1794).

Immanuel Case bought of Richard Phillips, January 28, 1785 (acknowledgement date). No house. (North Kingstown Land Evidence XV B-67).
