- SC-16-10 FIRST FLOOR: CENTER ROOM, WEST WALL
- SC-16-11 FIRST FLOOR: CENTER ROOM, MANTEL
- SC-16-12 FIRST FLOOR: NORTHWEST ROOM, MANTEL
- SC-16-13 FIRST FLOOR: SOUTHEAST ROOM, CORNER CUPBOARD (formerly in northwest room)
