
Historical Data:

In 1731, the strict Presbyterians among the Congregation of the Independent Church, left it and established a Church for themselves. They were incorporated in 1784. Their earlier church was replaced by the present massive structure dedicated in 1814 which was remodeled after the earthquake of 1886. The contrast, between the stern, rugged exterior and the highly finished comfortable interior, is striking.
