Historical Data:

Hibernian Hall, dedicated in 1841, is the home of the Hibernian Society which was founded March 17, 1801 by eight Irishmen who had recently arrived in the State. The Society is non-sectarian and non-political, and for years, the presidents have been selected, by unwritten law, alternately from Roman Catholic and Protestant members.
