WAMPEE

Near Pinopolis, Berkeley County, South Carolina

Owner: Santee-Cooper Hydroelectric and Navigation Project

Date of erection: Early nineteenth century

Present condition: Poor; in danger of inundation

Description:

Two stories; hipped roof; front porch balanced by shed extension in rear. Wampee in its general air is reminiscent of equivalent houses in the British West Indies. Its large windows, close-cut eaves, and pronounced bellcast heighten the resemblance, as well as the location of the chimneys in the rear where they are little seen, such features being ordinarily absent on West Indian buildings. It lacks any distinguished interior trim.

Plan: Two large rooms across front and two small first-floor rooms in rear shed, separated by a central hall.
