704 Mill Ave. (W. Court St.). Museum. Concrete, 46' x 53', one story with basement at the rear, the hip roof is a reservoir concealed by a broad horizontal fascia, a veranda surrounds three sides of the stem of the T-plan. The house was built by Colonel Joshua Young c.1851 for his daughter, Mrs. Katherine LeGette. It was for many years occupied by the family of Joseph Zorn, who served as mayor and postmaster.
