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Built in 1943, this large hangar, which closely resembles #412, faces south to the anchorage apron. It is accessible to the east of 4th Street. An OBH-2 type hangar, it is of "Mobilization," "Semi-Permanent" construction and was built from plan 117/6-1. Containing 12,796 square feet on one floor, it was built at a cost of \$175,000.00 by Harrison and Dorman Construction Company (H & D).

Building 800 has a concrete foundation and floor, with wood-frame walls and a truss roof. The main building measures 88 feet-2 inches by 122 feet-8 inches. Across the rear (north) wall is a one-story shed-roofed addition measuring 16 feet-1-inch by 104 feet-11 inches with an 8 feet by 12 feet-4 inches offset. The two wing walls, which actually serve as closets for the sliding doors, measure 8 feet-1 inches by 14 feet-7 inches each. In all respects (except for the size and number of window panes) the four elevations of this building are like that of #412. The height from the floor to the bottom of the truss is 25 feet-10 inches, and the exterior walls are clad with horizontal siding just like #412. The interior appointments are also similar, including the steam boiler, heaters, restroom and service equipment. Although needing paint, the building appears to be in sound condition.


