Built during the 1943 expansion of training and maintenance facilities along the anchorage apron, this administration and training building (also called a school building), is located north of hangar #800 in Block B. Of "Mobilization," "Semi-Permanent" type construction, the 9042 square foot structure was built for \$22,000.00 from plan W.B. 23-43 by R.D. Merrill Construction Company. The building was used to train men in installation, inspection and adjustment of armaments. It is also described as the "old bomb-sight building."


Rectangular in plan, this one-story building measures 65 feet-7 inches by 136 feet-7 inches and contains 9042 square feet of floor area. It has a concrete foundation and floor, wood frame walls with horizontal wood siding, and asphalt roll roofing. The roof slopes at a slight pitch from a central ridge. Along the long sides are bands of tall, small-paned windows, along with two garage doors on the south side. The doors on the east and west have mostly been sided over or boarded up except for double main doors in the west wall. Among the interior features is a vault. The building appears to be in good condition.
