This office building was built in 1943 as part of the expansion of facilities along the anchorage apron. It is essentially identical to buildings #807, #819, and #844, all of which were built from plan 700-5201.

This building has 3273 square feet on one floor and was built for \$3800.00 by H & D and Hart and Blanchard Construction Company. Dimensionally and architecturally similar to #819, the interior rooms and furnishings are also similar. See #819 for those details.

The north section of this building exterior has been painted and is being used as "Anderson's Service Center." The south section is unpainted, missing roofing and is in generally poor repair. The structure seems sound, however.


