This is one of several warehouses built in 1943 between the Western Pacific Railroad tracks and the spur line. This and #2219 are now the only two extant. Both buildings are 9600 square feet and were built by H & D for \$16,000 each from plan WB-25-24 type "Temporary," "Warehouse A.D.," "W-H-E-T."

The physical description for building 2219 also applies to building 2224. Except for the extent of wear, the buildings are identical. Building 2224 appears to be in slightly better condition.



