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The airmen's dormitory was constructed in 1943. The construction type was temporary with a wood foundation, wood floors, and wood walls. The roof was of asphalt roll construction. The building was originally heated with individual coal fired space heaters.


The building is 2,020 square feet with 20-foot-by-101-foot dimensions. The capacity of the building is 24 persons. The building is identical in use, plans, and appearance as buildings 2401, 2402, 2403, 2404 and others with the exception that the floors are wood without linoleum. The cost of the initial construction was \$3,200. The building appears to be structurally sound.
