Built in 1944, this "Mobilization," "Semi-Permanent" structure is identical to building 2606. It is 25 feet-4 inches by 150 feet-6 inches with an 8-foot-10-inch-by-27-foot-5-inch offset along the east. The offset is an open porch with a shed roof. The building's main entry is through a pair of doors at the north end, although there are also double doors at the south end. The building sits between buildings 2612 and 2621. It has four roof vents. The wood skirting covering the concrete block foundation piers has been removed from the south end. The building needs other maintenance work but appears to be in good condition structurally. See building 2606 for a comparable physical description.


