

Built in 1943, this building is identical in plan and appearance to building 2612, among others. It is located between buildings 2617 and 2626. It is 25 feet by 150 feet-6 inches with an 8-foot-10-inch-by-59-foot-10-inch offset. The building contains 4,278 square feet and was built for \$8,500. See the physical description of building 2612 for a comparable description of this building. Except for the removal of siding from upper gable end, the buildings seems to be in good condition.
