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Built in 1943, this is a "Mobilization," "Semi-Permanent" type of construction. It is similar to the other buildings in the 2600 series but is located by itself on a little circular drive off B Street (old A Street). Measuring 25 feet-4 inches by 99 feet 2-inches, the rectangular building has a 9-foot-by-25-foot offset on the front (south) side of the building. The latter constitutes the main entry to the building. The 2,791 square foot structure cost \$3,500 to build.

Building 2624 has a concrete foundation, wood frame floor and walls and a gabled roof with composition shingles. Its exterior has drop-lap siding (and some newer vertical siding on the south wall) and exposed rafter tails. The roof has four attic vents while the gable ends have large, louvered vents as well. The windows are 6/6 and the doors are wood paneled. In need of painting, the building seems otherwise in sound condition.


