This concrete block (tile?) building is constructed on a concrete slab and is located on the north side of the north road through the ordnance area. The building measures 27 feet-2 inches by 25 feet-5 inches. It is an SM-10 type structure built by H & D from plan WB 9-11. It has asbestos shingles in the gable and asbestos cement shingles on the roof. A single metal vent flue sits atop the roof. The broadside and a door opening (no door) face south. The gable ends have two, 9-pane windows each. The building appears to be structurally sound.


