Milking Barn

This barn is a cinderblock addition to the south wall of the livestock barn (UT-126-B). At the west end of this barn is a rectangular room with a gabled roof which is oriented north to south. This room has two four-light windows on the west wall and a single window on the south wall. The remainder of the cinderblock barn has a shed roof which slopes downward from the southern eaves of the livestock barn. The south side of the milking barn has a row of seven windows and a doorway at the east end. A single six-light window is present on the east side.
