Garage

This structure is a wood frame, plank sided garage located between the Thomas Powers residence (UT-126) and the large barn (UT-126-A). The garage is a rectangular building with a gabled roof which is oriented approximately east to west. Attached to the north side of this building is a wood frame, novelty sided addition covered with a shed roof which slopes downward to the north.

Access to the garage is through a set of double doors which fill most of the east wall. The double doors are wide enough to permit entry of a motor vehicle. A single wooden door is located in the center of the east wall of the addition. A small brick chimney protrudes through the roof of the northeast corner of the addition.
