modified Corinthian; double porch continues across rest of front in two bays and joins entrance portico with concave quadrant offset; addition north of wings, which are connected to porches by convex quadrant sections. River front simpler, three-bay superimposed portico, Doric and Ionic, with pedimented terminal pavilions, which have first-floor arched recesses flanked by coupled pilasters, louvered fans in tympana of pediments.
