since it was built. The house contains now twelve rooms and three halls including the basement. It is located three miles from King William Court House. The servants quarters is about 75 yards from the main dwelling. It is a brick building one story and half, containing four rooms with fire place in each room. The exact date of its erection is not know but it must have been built about 1820. "Green Level" is now owned by Mrs. Gay Taliaferro Hill, of King William, Virginia.
