FORT HILL FARM, Cool Storage Shed

HABS NO. VA-1288-M

- LOCATION: West of the Staunton (Roanoke) River between Turkey Run and Caesar's Run, Clover Vicinity, Halifax County, Virginia.
- SIGNIFICANCE: This building is a contributing element of Fort Hill Farm.
- DESCRIPTION: This log structure, measuring approximately 22 x 17 feet, may have been used for some type of cool storage. It is a half-story in height with a low, log knee-wall visible below the eave of the roof. The east-west gable roof is covered with galvanized, standing seam roofing. The gable peaks are sheathed with clapboards held in place with cut nails. Openings could not be identified, due to rampant vegetation, mostly poison ivy and briars.
- HISTORY: The date of construction for this building is not known.
