LOCATION: West Side of State Route 600, .8 mile North of State Route 778, Clover Vicinity, Halifax County, Virginia

SIGNIFICANCE: This log animal shed contributes to the significance of Edgewood Farm.

DESCRIPTION: This 16' X 20' animal shed is constructed of rough-hewn, diamond-notched logs, the walls chinked with wood and daubed with mud. It is sheathed with board-and-batten siding, with weatherboard at the gable peaks. The gable roof has pole rafters and is covered with seamed metal. A log-walled lean-to with vertical plank siding and seamed metal roof is located across the northwest end of the shed.

HISTORY: The construction date of this animal shed is unknown. The materials and method of construction, consistent with those of many other outbuildings on the farm, suggest that the shed was built in the late 19th or early 20th century.
