LOCATION: West Side of State Route 600, .8 mile North of State Route 778, Clover Vicinity, Halifax County, Virginia

SIGNIFICANCE: This domestic outbuilding is a contributing element of Edgewood Farm.

DESCRIPTION: This shed measures about 7' x 12'. It is of horizontal rough-hewn log construction with diamond corner notching. The shed has vertical planking on the exterior and a vertical plank door. The shed is set on a foundation of concrete block and unmortared bricks, the latter laid as three or four header courses. The interior walls are roughly clad with scrap lumber, and the floor is dirt. A heavy plank table is installed against the west (rear) wall.

HISTORY: The date of this building is unknown. The material and method of construction suggest that it was built in the late 19th or early 20th century.
