SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL, INCLUDE ORIGINAL USE OF STRUCTURE) Characteristic of early nineteenth-century residential buildings of Christiansted. The added interest is in the placement on the stepped site and the double curved grand stairway leading to a masonry bay centered against the front gallery.

MATERIAL OF CONSTRUCTION (INCLUDE STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS) Brick first-floor and projecting bay; wood frame second floor with shingles and clapboards.		
SHAPE AND DIMENSIONS OF STRUCTURE (SKETCHED FLOOR PLANS ON SEPARATE PAGES ARE ACCEPTABLE) L-shaped, with front facing northeast onto Hospital St. North ell extends towards Hospital St.		
EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE The main entrance, on the second floor, is reached by a symmetrical two-part curving stairway flanking the hexagonal projecting entrance bay. The bay is arcaded with pilasters and keystones. Cistern under bay. Hipped roof.
