OWNER:-- White Swan, Indian, Methodist Episcopal Church

DATE OF ERECTION:-- 1879

BUILDER:-- Indians

PRESENT CONDITION:-- Burned to the ground, January 1937.

NUMBER OF STORIES:-- One story

MATERIALS OF CONSTRUCTION:-- Frame construction, siding, shingle roof, stone foundation.

OTHER EXISTING RECORDS:-- The building was built under the direction of James H. Wilbur, Indian Commissioner and Pastor, who served as its leader for 23 years. The building of the structure was done by the Indians themselves and the land donated by them.
