<u>HABS No.</u>	<u>Description</u>
WA-213- 1	Context view looking NE from roof of Gould Hall shows Henry Gallery at left in distance. Street running to right is NE 40th Street entrance to the campus. Building at right is Meany Hall. Building at center right is Odegaard Library.
WA-213- 2	Context view looking NE from NE Campus Parkway shows skybridge (across 15th Avenue NE) connecting to Henry Gallery and site of new gallery addition on hill extending to right of gallery. Building at left is Schmitz Hall. Building at center right is Odegaard Library. Statue is George Washington. Building in far distance at right is Suzzallo Library.
WA-213- 3	Context view looking SE from roof of Schmitz Hall shows Henry Gallery on left and skybridge crossing 15th Avenue NE. Terraced landscape is the site of the new gallery addition. Buildings in near background are (left to right): Odegaard Library, Suzzallo Library and Meany Hall. Neoclassical building at right in distance is Architecture Hall. Tall building at right in far distance is University Hospital.
WA-213- 4	Elevation view of south facade (front) of Henry Gallery.
WA-213- 5	Elevation view of west side as seen from street level. Street in foreground is 15th Avenue NE.
WA-213- 6	Elevation view of west side as seen from roof of Schmitz Hall shows skylights on roof of Henry Gallery. Building immediately behind Henry Gallery is Odegaard Library.
WA-213- 7	Elevation view of north end (back).
WA-213- 8	Elevation view of east side was taken from portable hydraulic lift raised just high enough so that the base of the building would be visible. This side of the building will be obscured by the new addition. See also photos WA-213-14 through WA-213-20.
WA-213- 9	Oblique view taken with a 90mm wide-angle lens shows south facade and east side, including entire base of building on the south.

WA-213-10	Oblique view taken with a 180mm lens shows south facade and east side. This view is included to give a more normal perspective on the building, relative to the wide-angle photo WA-213- 9.
WA-213-11	Oblique view of front entry shows cast stone base and decorative masonry, projecting pylons, surrounding pointed arch entry opening and metal doors.
WA-213-12	Elevation view of east side, south part, shows details of southernmost projecting bay including pylons surrounding pointed arch, insert niche, cast stone decorative panels and figures at upper corners.
WA-213-13	Detail of masonry on south facade to the east of the front entry shows laid brick pattern, cast stone base and inscription band.
WA-213-14	Detail of masonry on east side shows brick diaper pattern and cast stone panels that form parapet at top.
WA-213-15	Elevation view of east side, north part, includes details partially obscured in photo WA-213- 8. Structure in foreground is air vent from underground parking garage.
WA-213-16	Oblique view of northernmost projecting bay on east side shows insert niche, decorative cast stone at upper corners, and five parapet panels.
WA-213-17	Detail of cast stone female Greek figure at top of building at SE corner of building.
WA-213-18	Detail of cast stone male Egyptian figure at top of building at NE corner of southernmost bay on east side. Floral panel at right is southernmost panel of parapet on east side.
WA-213-19	Detail of cast stone panels that form parapet on east side. Dove panel on left is adjacent to floral panel seen in photo WA-213-18.
WA-213-20	Detail of cast stone panels that form parapet on east side. Fish panel on left is same panel seen on right in photo WA-213-19.
WA-213-21	Interior view of central hall shows front entry doors in distance. Doorways on left and right in foreground lead to galleries.
WA-213-22	Interior view of lobby, looking west, shows decorative iron lantern, domed ceiling, cast stone and de Caen plaster walls with conche niches, marble and mosaic tile flooring. Stairway in distance leads to basement (see photos WA-213-28 and WA-213-29).
WA-213-23	Interior view of lobby, looking east, shows similar features as seen in photo WA-213-22, plus decorative doorhead above arched paired doors leading to gallery bookstore.
WA-213-24	Detail of cast stone frieze and molding which ring lobby. This segment is same as that seen on right in photo WA-213-23.
WA-213-25	Interior view of gallery bookstore looking SW shows details of bookstore doors and composite arch trim. Steel grillwork of front door is visible in distance.

WA-213-26	Interior view of gallery bookstore, looking east. This room was originally a gallery.
WA-213-27	Interior view of main gallery shows skylight, track lighting and oak parquet flooring. Door at right (south) leads to hallway seen in photo WA-213-21. Door at left leads to smaller gallery.
WA-213-28	View in basement room looking west shows freight elevator on right and stairs leading up to lobby on left (see also photo WA-213-22). Basement room is same as seen in photo WA-213-29.
WA-213-29	Basement gallery at foot of stairs. South wall is at right.
