WA-224-B-1	View looking NW from Avenue B shows Building 26 South in foreground and Building 26 North in background.
WA-224-B-2	View looking north shows east end of Building 26 South on left, large Atlas cedar tree on right, and rows of cedar trees along Avenue B in center distance.
WA-224-B-3	Oblique view of north side includes the east end addition constructed after the 1990 fire.
WA-224-B-4	Elevation view of north side.
WA-224-B-5	Oblique view of north side includes entrance that connected this building to original center portion which burned down in 1990.
WA-224-B-6	Elevation view of west end.
WA-224-B-7	Oblique view of SW corner. Road is same as that in WA-224-A-6.
WA-224-B-8	Oblique view of south side.
WA-224-B-9	Elevation view of east end of south side.
WA-224-B-10	Oblique view of eastern set of three dormer windows and cupola.
WA-224-B-11	Oblique view of west end of south side. Behind tree is west end addition constructed after the 1990 fire.
WA-224-B-12	View looking west on south side includes landscaped rose garden with semi-circular brick walkway.
WA-224-B-13	Detail of brick stairs on south side of rose garden.
WA-224-B-14	View looking west in first floor hallway. Room No. 125 on right is last room at east end.
