- WA-246-1 CROCKETT BARN FROM ACROSS CROCKETT LAKE,
LOOKING NORTHWEST. A bridge once spanned Crockett
Lake. The pylons are all that remain. The Crockett barn's hipped
roof can be seen just under the tree line left of center.
- WA-246-2 CROCKETT BARN AND BLOCKHOUSE FROM SOUTH
FORT CASEY ROAD, LOOKING SOUTHEAST. The
Crockett blockhouse was moved from its original location to a
tract of land along South Fort Casey Road in 1938, making it
more accessible to tourists. During the same year it was given to
the Daughters of the Pioneers of Washington and restored by
Works Progress Administration crews.
