- WA-248-A-1 EXTERIOR PERSPECTIVE FROM BARN YARD SHOWING EAST AND SOUTH FAÇADES OF THE BARN, LOOKING NORTHWEST. The sliding door on the barn's east façade leads into the animal pens and milking stalls. The barn's hip-on-gable roof is covered in corrugated metal. The gable end is clad in board and battens, matching the rest of the barn's exterior. The pump house can be seen to the north; the garage to the west.
- WA-248-A-2 CENTRAL DRIVE RUNNING PAST THE GARAGE AND TERMINATING AT THE BARN. The barn's primary entrance is through the central double doors with chamfered corners on the west façade. The garage was used both as a mechanic shop and to park vehicles. The hipped roof of the pump house can be seen behind the garage.
- WA-248-A-3 INTERIOR OF THE BARN LOOKING EAST. The photograph was taken from the concrete flooring of the central space. The change in floor height can be seen behind the chairs on the left. Also seen is the barn's structural system of posts and collar beams with diagonal or block braces.
