Location: Wheeling, Ohio County, West Virginia

Significance: Turn of the century frame house that is a contributing structure in the Wheeling Island Historic District.

Description: This house faces Zane Street and is a two story frame irregular block. It has a hipped roof. A secondary gable corners a second story angled bay window. A large two story addition to the rear with a hipped roof nearly doubles the size of the house. The house has a full basement. Alterations include; new doors in changed openings and the front porch redone with wood and aluminum. Also, the gutters have been removed.

History: Date of Construction: ca. 1900. According to the Ohio deed record the house at 182 Zane Street can be traced back to April 1941 when it belonged to a Bajus or a DeLoretto. It was purchased by Ernest and Margaret Messimer in April of 1946. When Mr. Messimer died in 1950, Mrs. Messimer sold the house to Ollie J. Jewell, Sr. who had the property until 1961. In that year, the house was deeded to Mr. Jewell's son, Ollie Jr. and his wife Dolores. It was then bought in 1982 by Aliceann and Cloyd Vandevender. The Vandevender's sold the house for \$22,000 to Stephen R. Siembab in 1984. The Wheeling National Bank obtained ownership of the property in 1987 and sold it to Robert and Sharon Holliday in January, 1989. The Hollidays owned the house until August, 1991, when it was purchased by the West Virginia Division of Highways. 182 Zane Street became a contributing structure of the Wheeling Island Historic District in April, 1992.








