This was once the railway station at Guillemont. A freight train was standing by it. Then the big guns got its range, and this is what remains. The freight train is the only part of the original landscape that retains any semblance of form. The station is gone: the remnants of the tracks may be seen in the lower left hand corner, and the trees behind the station are blown to kindling. It will be seen that none of this destruction has been caused by burning, much as it resembles the work of flames, but is entirely the result of a shattering shell fire.
