Personally I believe that this act is trying to aquire some decent limitations and rules concerning copyright issues. The language used to embody this law, however, leads to many undesireable results. Such as the restriction of legitimate uses of "copyright circumvention." Uses may include the holding of so-called "backup" copies of music which the possesor has previously purchased, the reverse engineering of programs in order to find code that could be malicious to a user's system, etc. Of course these freedoms will be misused by some, but I believe that the negative impact far outreaches the positive. Please reconsider the impact of this law thouroughly before enacting it. -Dave Diamante
