Dear Ms. Charlesworth:

On behalf of DVD CCA and AACCS LA, we are submitting the following response to the below post-hearing questions to Proposed Class 7: Audiovisual works—derivative uses—noncommercial remix videos.

Copyright Office Questions:

1. At the hearing, participants discussed the scope of the current exemption for “noncommercial videos,” including whether this category should be more specifically delineated than it is in the current exemption and, in that regard, whether it should be understood to encompass videos made for educational purposes. In light of this discussion, please provide your proposed interpretation and definition of “noncommercial video” and address any concerns with respect to amending or maintaining the language of the current exemption.
