AMENDED COPYRIGHT REVISION BILL REPORTED BY THE  
SUBCOMMITTEE ON PATENTS,  
TRADEMARKS AND COPYRIGHTS TO THE SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

On April 16, 1974, the bill for general revision of the Copyright Law (Title 17, United States Code), S. 1361, bearing the date April 9, 1974, was reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute by the Subcommittee on Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights to the Senate Committee on the Judiciary (93d Congress, 2d Session).

The bill as originally introduced by Senator John L. McClellan on March 26, 1973, has been rewritten to incorporate a number of changes, both formal and substantive, approved by the Subcommittee.
