A N N O U N C E M E N T

Public Law 89-651, the "Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Materials Importation Act of 1966," implements the Florence Agreement and made the importation of certain books duty-free effective February 1, 1967. It should be noted carefully that neither this new law nor the Florence Agreement has any effect on the United States copyright law. English language books subject to the import restrictions of the copyright law will continue to be subject to such restrictions, and the Bureau of Customs will continue to examine imported books in relation to the copyright law.
