A N N O U N C E M E N T

On April 11, 1967, the House of Representatives passed, with certain amendments, H. R. 2512, the bill for the general revision of the copyright law, and referred it on April 12 to the Senate as an Act of the House of Representatives.

S. 597, a companion bill to H. R. 2512 as introduced, is pending in the Senate, which has not yet acted on it. The Subcommittee on Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights of the Senate Judiciary Committee is currently considering the revision bill.
