Harpersville, Talladega County, Alabama.

Ownership:

Present Owner: I. S. Chancellor. From 1908 to the present time.  
Previous Owners: William Chancellor. From 1860 to 1908.  
Mr. Fluker. From 1835 to 1860.

Date of Erection: 1835.

Architect: Unknown.

Builder: Mr. Fluker.

Present Condition: Very good: A new roof is being added, it is badly in need of painting. The original structure remains intact. The old milk house is the only outhouse standing, and in use.

Number of Stories: One.

Materials of Construction: Frame house, with composition shingle roof. The foundation is of brick pillars, the exterior walls are of 6" heart of pine weather-boarding, the interior walls, and ceiling are of 12" unplanned boards which have been papered. It has two exterior chimneys. The front porch is narrow, it is 16' long with 12" box columns. The floors are of 6" heart of pine flooring.

Additional Data: Mr. William Chancellor came from Scotland with his father at the age of twelve. His father settled in Coosa County and later moved to Talladega County.
