General Fremont's House (CAL-121)

Structure

History: Building appears on old Navarez map and assessed to Dr. James Stokes in 1851. Probably used as headquarters by Fremont as he camped with troops when here in 1846. Had been used for military purposes by General Castro and later part of property belonged to Molera Estate. Now restored by History and Art Association and rented as office.

Description: Small two-story street-front adobe with
(Over)



rustic facing and gable end, shingle roof. Two-story veranda supported by chamfered wood posts and with outside stairway to second story veranda.
