Occidental Hotel (CAL-1162)

Structure

History: Building now destroyed. Built 1861, Johnson and Mooser, architects. Considered the city's finest hotel at the time. Extension added in 1865. 412 rooms. J. Donohoe, Owner.

Description: Five-story brick, stucco, stone and cast iron. Pilasters with arched openings at ground floor support entablature. Tall narrow, paired double hung windows at upper floors. Window frames have pediments
(Over)

at second floor, flat at third floor and segmented at fourth floor, all set in a plain field with quoins at corner of building and bracketed cornice with fifth story windows between brackets and surmounted by balastered parapet. Central element of five bays projects slightly and composes with pediment at roof line and with free standing colonade at street entrance and balcony at second and third stories.
