killed in fire which destroyed house in 1915PUBLISHED
DRAWINGSDescription - 2½ story frame with siding;
modified gable roof (canted ends of peak
over front portion) of shingles. Original
(over)

house had porch exact width of front - later extended to both sides, around corner, with enclosed area at left. Stick house with squared bay window, first floor side, with small shingled Mansard roof over. Shingling under gable ends of front section of house.
