THE GEORGE BALDWIN HOUSE

This small Greek Revival House was erected about 1832 by George Baldwin from a design believed to have been executed by Ithiel Towne, Architect.

The peculiar features of the house were the built-in ~~the~~ wall chimneys of which there were four, one from each of the four rooms on the first floor and which have been recently removed.
