SW corner of Potomac and Grace Sts., N.W. (Georgetown).
Brick, rectangular, 40'-2" (two-bay front) x 129'-6"
(12 bays), four stories with fully exposed basement on
south, millrace tunnels beneath, flat roof, open plan.
Built 1845 by Col. George Bomford as a cotton mill,
converted to a flour mill in 1866, altered 1883 and
1932. Only old mill remaining in Georgetown. 3 ext.
