Builder: Ben Cameron, Sr.

Present Condition: Poor.

Number of Stories: Two; Faces South.

Materials of Construction: Brick foundation, frame exterior walls.

Other Existing Records: Page from City Builder.

Additional Data: Low paneled chair rail in left room with mantel. Dado rail in right room with plaster below. Center front hall with curved stairs and five rooms on each floor. Four columns across front.

Original owner, Ben Cameron, Sr., who built house with slave labor. There was a garden and summer house to the East, originally. Information on history furnished by Leslie Dallis, of LaGrange.
